

Policy Title: School Publications

Policy No: 503.03

Official school publications such as school newspapers reflect the policy and judgment of the student editors. Students have the responsibility to refrain from libel and obscenity, and to observe the normal rules for responsible journalism. Within these bounds students have a right, and are as free as editors of other newspapers to report the news and to editorialize.

Any newspaper printed by a Journalism or Publications class for school credit will have staff supervision.
