

LOCAL TAX REVENUES

The St. Maries Joint School District No. 41 Board of Trustees, by the exercise of its taxing power, shall provide the funds necessary to finance the operation of the schools. All money expended by the District shall be accounted for and disbursed directly by the Board of Trustees. The Board directs the Superintendent to provide necessary procedures for efficient and lawful transactions with the County Treasurer.

STATE AID AND FEDERAL AID

The Superintendent shall develop and maintain procedures that guarantee needed State aid for the operation of the District and shall cause the District to actively participate in special programs funded by the State relevant to the District's educational philosophy.

The Board regards federal aid to education as an extension of local tax dollars and directs the Superintendent to study all federal legislation and to select those aid programs which will help the Board meet the educational goals of the District.

STATE AND FEDERAL AID ELIGIBILITY DETERMINATION

The Superintendent shall develop and maintain necessary procedures to determine St. Maries Joint School District No. 41's eligibility for state and federal aid programs that are relevant to the District's educational philosophy.
