

VISION STATEMENT

St. Maries Joint School District No. 41's Vision Statement is "*Committed to Quality Education*".

MISSION STATEMENT

The District's Mission Statement is "St. Maries Joint School District No. 41 is dedicated to providing an educational culture that will continually assess the knowledge, changing needs, and challenges of our students and adapt our practices to prepare them to become successful citizens."

GOALS

1. St. Maries Joint School District No. 41's staff will measure and improve communication between all stakeholders in the District during the 2017-2018 school year through the following activities:
 - A. Create a uniform District parent contact log.
 - B. Collect and tabulate parent contact data quarterly.
 - C. Set building and District parent contact goals for the second, third, and fourth quarters after setting a baseline in the first quarter of the 2017-2018 school year.
 - D. The Superintendent of Schools will create and send weekly e-mail correspondence to the Board of Trustees.
 - E. Consider the purchase and launch of Skylert, the mass communications software available through Skyward, the District's student data management system.
 - F. Schedule student academic presentations at the regular monthly Board meetings.
 - G. Schedule regular meetings between St. Maries Joint School District No. 41 designated representatives, local businesses, District patrons, and identified institutions of higher learning.
2. St. Maries Joint School District No. 41 staff will increase student proficiency in English Language Arts and Math by providing high quality instruction in a safe learning environment as measured by the Idaho Reading Indicator (IRI), Idaho Standards Achievement Test (ISAT), End-of-Course Assessments, and graduation rates by the Spring of 2018 through the following activities:
 - A. Provide Math professional development to all District Math teachers.

- B. Provide English Language Arts professional development to all District English Language Arts teachers.
 - C. Provide “Safe Schools” on-line professional development to all certified and classified staff.
 - D. Create and administer a staff survey to gauge staff development needs, morale, and level of trust.
3. St. Maries Joint School District No. 41 Board of Trustees will create a Plant Facilities Committee during the 2017-2018 school year to identify improvements that are needed in existing structures and grounds. Additionally, the Committee will identify the need for additional or replacement structures as well as the possibility of providing the necessary learning facilities needed for college and career ready pathways through the following activities:
- A. Create a Plant Facilities Committee and set a regular meeting schedule.
 - B. Evaluate current District facilities for safety concerns.
 - C. Evaluate current facilities for needed improvements.
 - D. Prioritize identified areas of concern.
4. St. Maries Joint School District No. 41 Board of Trustees will meet annually to evaluate District programs to ensure that program offerings are meeting the needs of the District through the following activities:
- A. Set an annual meeting date to review District programs.
 - B. Discuss District programs in Budget Workshop meetings.
 - C. Identify local needs through stakeholder input.
