

**Policy Title: District Title IX Coordinator
Civil Rights Grievance Coordinator**

Policy No: 305.01

Public school systems in receipt of federal funds, including public school districts such as St. Maries Joint School District No. 41 must designate at least one professional employee as a Title IX Coordinator to oversee compliance efforts and investigate any complaints of sex discrimination.

The Board of Trustees of St. Maries Joint School District No. 41 has designated the District Superintendent to serve as the District's Title IX Coordinator as well as the District's Civil Rights Grievance Coordinator to address any and all Civil Rights complaints or concerns.

The duties and responsibilities of this Coordinator shall include, but not be limited to:

1. Annually review the Civil Rights and Title IX policies and procedures of the District as well as all non-discrimination policies and procedures for the District, including making recommendations for appropriate changes when necessary;
2. Dissemination of the District's Non-Discrimination Policies and Procedures to all the District's students and staff, including posting at school locations, placement in various school newsletters and notices, and in various school handbooks as such may exist from time to time;
3. Education of the District's students and staff relating to the non-discrimination policies and procedures;
4. Coordination and implementation of the District's grievance procedures in the instance of a complaint;
5. Assurance of proper disciplinary, corrective and educative measures for students and/or personnel whose actions are in violation of the District's non-discrimination policies;
6. Monitoring the overall implementation of Title IX for the school as well as any other non-discrimination program applicable to the school;
7. Taking steps necessary to educate students and staff as to prevention of sexual harassment and discrimination; and
8. Supervising and chairing any school committees that may be created from time to time to address non-discrimination programs and related issues.

All complaints of non-compliance with Title IX or any other allegation of discriminatory conduct shall be reported to:
