

St. Maries Joint School District No. 41 agrees to permit qualified students of an institution of higher learning, having registered for practice teaching in elementary or secondary schools, the privilege of using St. Maries Joint School District No. 41 schools for observation and practice teaching.

The program of practice teaching in St. Maries Joint School District No. 41 shall be under the supervision of the Superintendent of Schools or his delegated representative.

The instructor for the college in charge of teacher training shall have the privilege of visiting the student teacher who is working in St. Maries Joint School District No. 41 at any time.

The detail of the practice teaching program is to be worked out by the Superintendent and the individual in charge of teacher training for the institution of higher learning.

ASSIGNMENT OF STUDENT TEACHERS

One student per teacher per year is recommended.

A teacher and the principal may decide that it is advantageous for certain teachers to have more than one student teacher a year.

The principal shall consult with the teacher well in advance of assigning him/her a student teacher.
