

Any student in attendance at any school in St. Maries Joint School District No. 41 shall remain on campus throughout the school day. Exceptions include:

1. Lunch passes may be granted to students who live within walking distance and who have provided the principal with a parental request for a lunch pass;
2. Any student leaving the school campus for reasons of sickness, etc., must be cleared through their respective school office;
3. A parent or guardian wishing to pick up their child for doctor appointments, etc., must be cleared through the school's office; and
4. Any student on a work permit.

Students leaving the school grounds for other reasons during the school day must check out through the school office.

VEHICLE REGULATIONS

Since St. Maries Joint School District No. 41 provides bus transportation according to state law, driving a vehicle to school by students is a privilege granted by the Board of Trustees. Accordingly, any student attending school who intends to drive a vehicle to school must comply with the following regulations:

1. Driver must have a valid driver's license;
2. Vehicle must have proper registration and insurance certificates;
3. Parking of student vehicles must be in the designated area;
4. The vehicle is to be parked and not moved until the end of the student's school day; (Exception: If the vehicle is necessary for a school-related activity such as teacher's aide or the student has signed out through the office.)
5. Students are not to sit in vehicles during school hours or during lunch;
6. If permission to drive a student's vehicle to school is withdrawn, it cannot be driven to school by someone else or parked in the vicinity of the school; and
7. Parking in a non-designated area will be by permit only.
