

The valedictorian will be chosen after the seventh (7th) semester and shall be the student with the highest Grade Point Average (G.P.A.) in the graduating class.

The salutatorian will be chosen after the seventh (7th) semester and shall be the student with the second highest Grade Point Average (G.P.A.) in the graduating class.

In case of a tie for valedictorian, all qualifying students will be honored. When there is a tie for salutatorian all qualifying students will be honored. Each honored valedictorian and salutatorian or co-valedictorian and co-salutatorian will be chosen to speak at graduation.

Both the valedictorian and salutatorian address must be filed with the principal for approval one (1) week prior to graduation.

All graduating seniors who have an eighth (8th) semester Grade Point Average (G.P.A.) of 3.00 or better will be recognized as graduating with honors.
