

Since St. Maries Joint School District No. 41 provides bus transportation according to state law, driving a vehicle or motorcycle to school by students is a privilege granted by the Board of Trustees. Accordingly, any student attending school who intends to drive a vehicle or motorcycle to school must comply with the following regulations:

1. Student must assume full responsibility for the use and care of his/her vehicle or motorcycle;
2. Student must have a valid driver's license;
3. Student must comply with all state and local laws;
4. Vehicle or motorcycle must have proper registration and insurance certificates;
5. Parking of student vehicles or motorcycles must be in designated areas;
6. Student's vehicle or motorcycle is to be parked and not moved until the end of the student's school day. (Exception: If the vehicle is necessary for a school-related activity such as teacher's aide or the student has signed out through the office.)
7. Students are not to sit in vehicles or on motorcycles during school hours or during lunch.
8. If permission to drive a student's vehicle or motorcycle to school is withdrawn, the vehicle or motorcycle cannot be driven to school by someone else or parked in the vicinity of the school.
9. Parking in a non-designated area will be by permit only.
