

It shall be the policy of St. Maries Joint School District No. 41 to encourage adult education.

1. All adult education shall be administered by the Superintendent and authority delegated by him or her as the need arises.
2. The instructor shall be recommended by the Superintendent and hired by the Board of Trustees.
3. Adult classes shall meet all requirements of federal and state laws as well as the requirements of the sponsoring institution.
4. All classes shall be approved by the Board of Trustees before classes commence.
5. All payments, expenses, and salaries must be approved by the Board of Trustees.
6. The use of facilities and buildings for adult classes shall be governed by written regulations related to buildings and equipment.
7. Adults 21 years of age and over desiring the privilege of free education must have approval from the Board of Trustees.
