

A reasonable amount of homework for students is beneficial. However, the District recognizes that school is only part of a student's life and that students must have time to participate in other activities.

Primary children (grades 1 - 3) should be given little, if any, homework. Children in the upper elementary grades should have no more than one (1) hour of homework per day.

Teachers should ensure that:

1. Assignments to be done at home are meaningful and relative to the curriculum being taught; and
2. Students are capable of completing the assigned homework.

There will be exceptions to the time limitations expressed in this Policy because of students who have missed school or are subject to other extenuating circumstances.
