

District Continuous Goals

- St. Maries Joint School District #41 staff will measure and improve communication between all stakeholders in our District during the 2020-2021 school year.
 - Collect and tabulate parent contact data quarterly
 - Set building and District parent contact goals
 - Create and send weekly email from superintendent to Board of Trustees
 - Schedule academic presentations at monthly Board meetings
 - Create District informational flyer to distribute in local businesses and offices.

- St. Maries Joint School District #41 staff will increase student proficiency in English Language Arts and Math as measured by Idaho Reading Indicator, Idaho Standards Achievement Test, End of Course Assessments, and graduation rates by the spring of 2021. Due to the impact of COVID-19, growth goals reflect growth from Spring 2019 data.
 - The District will maintain the cohort graduation rate
 - The District will increase the percent of students reaching college ready benchmark on the SAT/ACT by 12%
 - The District will increase ISAT Math proficiency by 15%
 - The District will increase ISAT Language Arts proficiency by 10%
 - The District will increase Istation proficiency by 10%
 - The District will maintain EOC proficiency
 - The District will increase EL student proficiency in one or more of the four domains as measured on the ACCESS 2.0
 - The District EL students will meet or exceed individual growth goals as measured by local academic measures.

- St. Maries Joint School District #41 Board of Trustees will meet annually to evaluate programming to ensure that program offerings are meeting the needs of the District.
 - Discuss programming in budget consideration meetings
 - Identify local needs through stakeholder input
